Hart District Council is the Data Controller for the personal information you provide on this form.

Purpose of the processing

The personal information you provide will be used to allow the Council to process and assess your application for the Hart Lottery in accordance with the Council's statutory duties under the Gambling Act 2005.

Categories of personal information being processed

- Name;
- E-mail address.

Legal basis for the processing

- Legal Obligation (For example, the Council is legal obliged to process and assess all relevant applications received);
- Public Task (For example, it is in the public interest that the Council investigates complaints alleging breaches or offences committed under the regulations).

Who your personal information may be shared with

- The Gambling Commission;
- Gatherwell;
- The Police.

How long will your personal information be kept

Your personal information will be held by the Council for 2 years from the date of your last active registration.
