

Hart District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2024 (Amendment No 1) (Crossways Manor Car Park) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35, 122 (to ensure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic including pedestrians) and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Hampshire in accordance with Section 39 (3) of the Act of 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, proposes to make the following Order:

Title

The title of the Order, if made, will be the Hart District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2024 (Amendment No 1) (Crossways Manor Car Park) Order 2024.

The effect of the Order will be

1. To reduce the 2 hours free parking provision to 30 minutes.
2. To correct a typographical error and to clarify wording in schedule.
