Hart District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2024 (Amendment No 1) (Crossways Manor Car Park) Order 2024 Statement of Reasons

Hart District Council ("the Council"), in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1984, and all other enabling enactments, makes provision for off-street parking places within its district.

The Council proposes to amend the Hart District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2024.

The intention of the amendment to the Order will be:

- 1. To reduce the duration of free parking offered in Crossways Manor car park from 2 hours to 30 minutes.
- 2. To correct a typographical error and to clarify wording in schedule.

The reason(s) for the amendment to the Order is:

- a. To secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway in line with S122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- b. To meet the request from Hook Parish Council to maximise the benefits to residents of the free vend parking in Crossways Manor car park.
