Application to the High Court:

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1,2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I,II,III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by Friday 28 February 2025 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
